- Photos must be submitted through this website. Files must be between 1MB and 2 MB in size to be considered.
- Participants must have permission from any persons pictured in the photo to use that
 photo and permission of a parent in the case of minors. Photos MAY be reproduced by
 the magazine.
- Once submitted, photos become property of the magazine.
- Each individual may submit up to five photos total, with no more than 3 in any one category.
- Each photo must be submitted in one of the following categories:
 - People and Families: People living, working and enjoying themselves in the community
 - o Wildlife and Nature: Plants, parks, animals in nature, natural landscapes
 - Activities and Events: Community gatherings, sporting events
 - o City Landmarks: Businesses, buildings, cityscapes
 - Pets: Domestic animals
- Contest organizers reserve the right to disqualify or re-categorize any photo.
- Winners will be notified on or around Oct. 1, 2014. Finalists in each category will receive gift certificates to local restaurants and businesses.
- All decisions will be final; judges reserve the right to award a winner in any category.
- The magazine will not by responsible for lost entries.
- Depending on the number of entrants, a winner may be chosen for each category as well as an overall winner. A "Reader's Choice" award may also be given based on votes received on the magazine's website Sept. 10-30.
- Select photographs may also be featured in future issues of the magazine
